



# Safeguarding Brief Sheet

Everyone involved with New Baby Network CIC has a responsibility to keep children and vulnerable adults safe.

In the absence of the above safeguarding lead, the next person in line will be: **Phillipa Cresswell**

Your safeguarding responsibilities are:

1. To complete application and recruitment process honestly and completely
2. To be familiar with, and follow the full safeguarding policy
3. To download and familiarise yourself with the NHS safeguarding app, which includes all local contact details
4. Be aware of the types and indicators of abuse
5. Report any suspicions, signs or communications of abuse to the lead designated safeguarding person using the reporting form
6. To contact emergency services if you suspect someone you are supporting, or a member of their family is at risk of harm or in immediate danger
7. To access regular supervision and ongoing training
8. To share information where relevant and appropriate
9. Respect all you are supporting/work alongside regardless of their age, ability, sex, sexual orientation or ethnicity
10. Place the safety and wellbeing of the children, young people and vulnerable adults first, above any personal or organisational goals and before loyalty to friends and family
